#### **Carroll to show off new coed dormitory**

**Waukesha** — Carroll University is ready to unveil a newly constructed coed dormitory that is accommodating 264 students.

An open house is scheduled for 4 to 6 p.m. Saturday at Pioneer Hall, a four-story dormitory that houses students in what Carroll describes as "sex-specific quad apartments."

Each apartment has four bedrooms, two bathrooms, a living room and a kitchen. The building also includes air-conditioning, underground parking, an exercise facility, a coffee shop and a computer lab.

Construction on Pioneer Hall, 324 W. College Ave., started in January by Clysmic Properties of Waukesha.

Waukesha's private, four-year college has struggled in recent years with growing enrollment and limited student housing options.
